I am a Midwest based cinematographer. I began my photography career as a wire service photographer working for UPI, the AP, Agence France Presse and Gamma Liaison. I spent seven seasons as the staff photographer for the Milwaukee Brewers Baseball Club before redirecting my focus to cinematography. Since then, I have had the good fortune to shoot thousands of television commercials and work on several films. In 2011 I shot *Profile of a Killer*, a feature film written and directed by acclaimed screenwriter Caspian Tredwell-Owen. A short documentary I shot in 2021 won an Emmy award for Outstanding Achievement for Human Interest - Short Form Content.
